



Criteria for UWF High School Scholarship Award Academic Year 2017-2018

- Three awards will be given - one for each Jefferson County High School for a woman graduating in 2017 with a **GPA of 3.5 or greater** who plans to enroll for full-time university study in 2017; or to enroll during 2017 in a community college for course(s) that are required preliminary to university study.
- The award will be made for tuition **up to \$2,500** at any accredited four-year college or university, or at a community college as set out above, and will be disbursed directly to the school each quarter or semester.
- Payment of the award will be made to your college after you enroll. If you have not enrolled by the second term of the school year, the scholarship will be void.
- Award of the scholarship will be based on:
 - Academic performance
 - Educational and professional goals
- Portfolios containing the material referred to below must be sent to the UWF Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 644 Port Townsend WA **postmarked by March 10, 2017**.

Applicants will be considered who supply all of the following:

1. A complete and signed application form provided on the AAUWPT website (pt-wa.aauw.net)
2. High school transcript (official if possible)
3. SAT score and class rank if known
4. Name of school you plan to attend or schools you have applied to
5. Short statement of plans and goals
6. Portfolio containing details of any community, school or extra-curricular projects you want considered
7. Details of financial needs and resources
8. Three (3) letters of recommendation, at least one from a teacher

The award will be presented at a UWF Scholars' Reception on **May 13, 2017**.
