The Mission-Related Projects Vice President Director provides leadership to the School-Based Projects Committee, its programs, and activities. The Committee is comprised of the Co-Chairs of the literacy and math educational projects funded by UWF, Career Day Co-Chairs and the Higher Education Liaison.

The responsibilities of the Mission-Related Projects Vice President are:

- 1. Attend monthly Board Meetings and Provide Board with monthly updates of the M-R Projects Committee activities as appropriate.
- 2. Meet with Project Co-chairs at strategic times during the year to facilitate organization, volunteer outreach and coordination
 - a. Update strategic plan for projects to keep up to date with community needs. This may entail starting or ending projects.
- 3. Appoint Committee Chairs and Co-chairs
- 4. Meet annually with School Administration and Co-chairs to develop project goals and metrics to measure success.
- Review all applications for educational projects with regard to purpose, implementation and measurements for success and to make recommendations to the Board for approval and forwarding to UWF for funding.
