



## Criteria for “CAP” Scholarship in memory of Constance Anna Pash

University Women’s Foundation  
*of Jefferson County*

- This award of **\$4,000** will be made to a woman for tuition, fees and required course materials. It may be used at any accredited college/university or graduate school.
- The award will be submitted to your college upon your enrollment. If you have not enrolled by the second term of the school year, the scholarship will be void. Payment will be made directly to your college.
- You must be a resident of East Jefferson County WA.
- You must be a student who is a high school graduate and currently is a college student, and your field of study must be within the STEM fields (Science, Technology, Engineering or Math), with preference for math-based disciplines.
- Award of the scholarship will be based on:
  - Educational and professional goals
  - Academic performance
  - Financial need

Applications and information are available on the AAUW Port Townsend website UWF section [pt-wa.aauw.net/university-womens-foundation-uwf/scholarships/](http://pt-wa.aauw.net/university-womens-foundation-uwf/scholarships/) and must be returned **postmarked by March 6, 2022**.

Applicants will be evaluated according to the following:

1. Completed application, including:
  - Name of the school you are attending or plan to attend
  - Total number of credits required to obtain the degree sought
  - Projected year of graduation
  - Amount of tuition for the coming year
  - Proposed budget to cover education costs in the coming year
2. An essay of no more than two pages describing your educational and professional goals, which may detail past honors, awards, positions of leadership, school activities and other relevant information.
3. Official transcripts covering all completed college work (if any); plus, if you are a college freshman, high school transcript and (if available) SAT score and MCAT score if relevant.
4. Three letters of recommendation sent directly to UWF.

The UWF Scholarship Committee will select finalists for interviews. The winner will be **selected in April of the coming year**. Applicants should not be a member of the UWF scholarship committee, or an immediate family member, nor an immediate family member of the donor of the scholarship.
